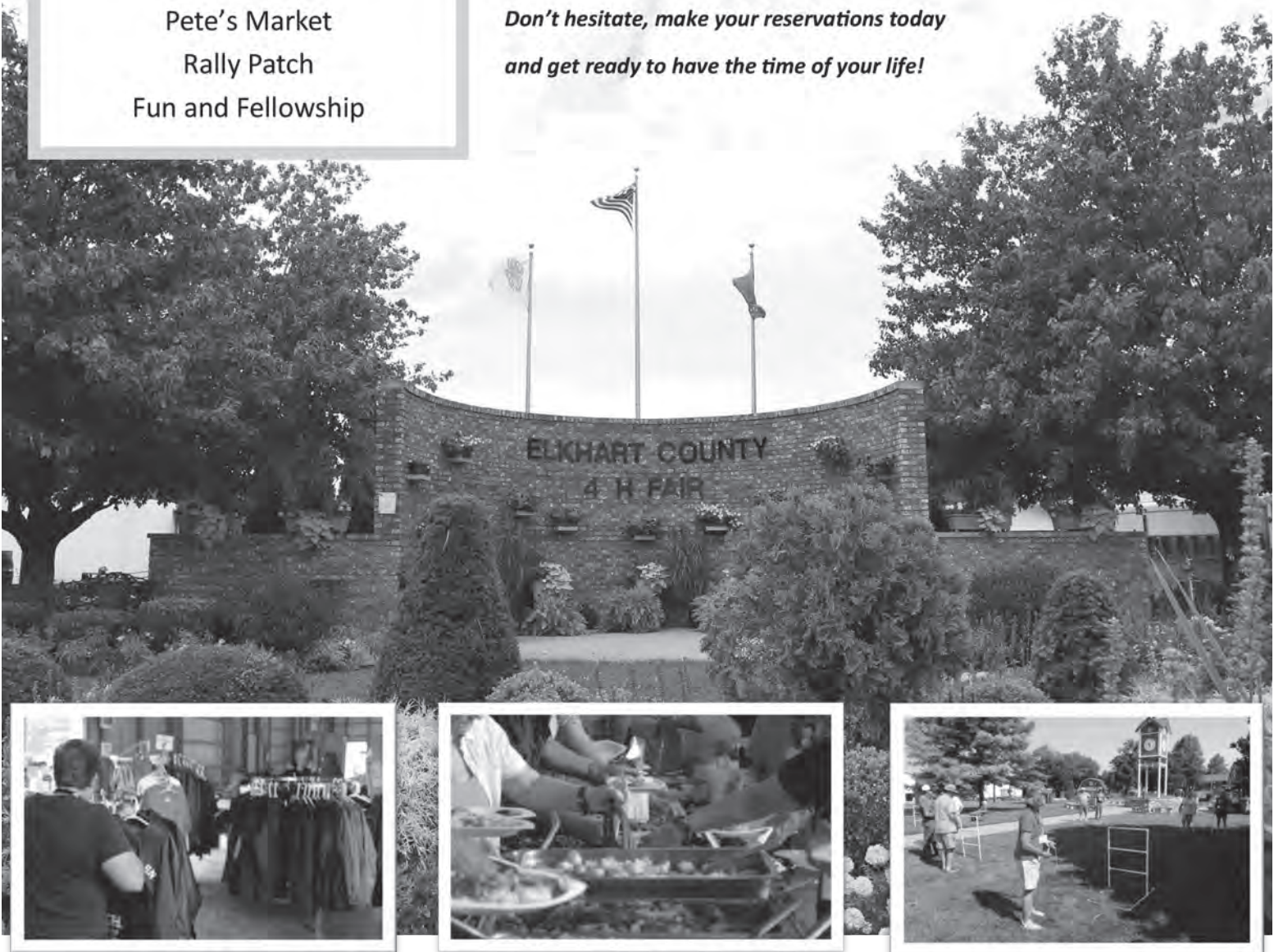

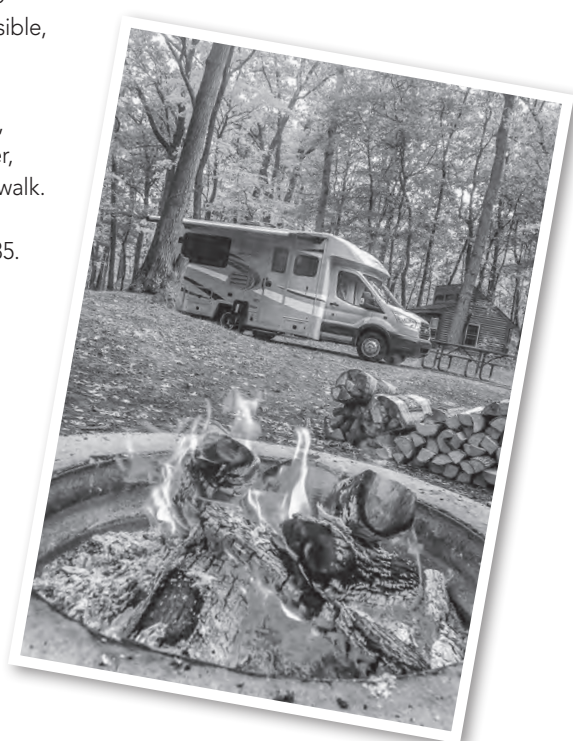

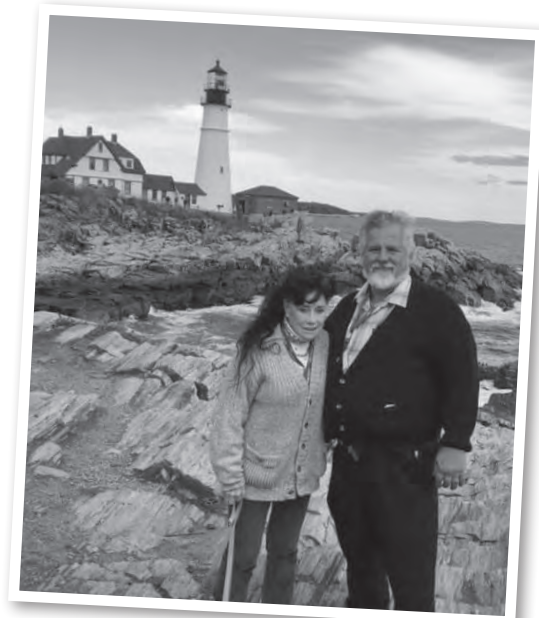

The Lyttles wrote this letter with gratitude and vivid detail. It's worth the read and their memories of a lifetime are what we wish upon all our owners. Happy trails, Lyttles! We're so glad you're a part of our family.

The Leprechaun sat in our driveway for a few months while I finished working out my arranged retirement as Cindy outfitted the rig beautifully, turning a coach into a home.

I retired October 1 and on Oct. 5, Cindy and I climbed locked up our house, loaded our final few items, including our 10-year-old Springer spaniel Kasey and our 12-year-old cat Oreo, closed the garage door, and backed out of the driveway full of excitement, and a little bit of fear. Our 32-foot motorhome was still a stranger to us. We'd never even tent-camped together, much less spent a year in a home on wheels. I'd only taken three test drives, including the drive home from Cincinnati. Just backing out of the drive had me nervous — I asked Cindy to spot me outside. I'd never driven anything remotely large, and now it was filled with enough of our belongings to serve as home for a year. Needless to say, it wasn't something we wanted to see dumped on the highway.

But with time and miles, our fears subsided. Our excitement did not.

We returned home Friday, Oct. 11 — a year and a week later. In that time, we covered 16,000 miles, spent at least one night in 84 different campgrounds in 32 different states. We visited 16 different National Parks. We enjoyed Thanksgiving at the Biltmore mansion in North Carolina. We enjoyed Easter listening to the Rev. Al Green (he of "Let's Stay Together" singing fame) preach at his church in Memphis, followed by a trip through Elvis's Graceland.

We were forced to leave one camp as the banks of the Mississippi River surged to flood stage. We had to leave our rig one night in Mississippi for the security of a shelter as tornadoes touched down around us. We felt the subtle shakes of a small 4.0 earthquake in Bozeman, Montana.

We were standing on a corner in Winslow, Arizona. We visited China Grove as "the sun came up on a sleepy little town, down around San Antonio." We weren't feeling no pain in Luckenbach, Texas.

We watched a rocket launch from Cape Canaveral, retraced Martin Luther King's steps across the Pettus Bridge in Selma, Alabama, and played air guitar on the site where the stage for Woodstock once stood.

We watched alligators in the Everglades and dolphins at sunset in Pensacola. A bald eagle watched me catch rainbow trout in the Salmon River in Idaho and we watched bison, mountain goats, pronghorn antelope and a bear walk past us at Yellowstone. I videotaped tarantulas walking through camp in Tucumcari, New Mexico, armadillos rooting about in Abilene and roadrunners bolting by in Arizona.



We rode horses through Monument Valley and rode up to the top of the Gateway Arch in St. Louis. We stood under Mt. Rushmore, the Devil's Tower and above Niagara Falls and the Grand Canyon. We ate beignets in New Orleans and barbecue in Austin. And we saw so many gorgeous sunsets, pristine beaches, breathtaking mountain peaks and thrilling mountain rivers to fill a lifetime of memories.

And through it all, nary a mishap. Our Leprechaun, which we dubbed Sally (as in, "ride, Sally, ride") became home so quickly and comfortably that we never, for a minute, felt cramped, or compromised or inconvenienced. We absolutely adore Sally.

At one point in time, we could never get water to our kitchen sink and couldn't figure out why. After a couple different service attempts, we ended up stopping by the Coachmen plant near Shipshewana, Indiana — a lovely, Amish area — and Coachmen couldn't have been nicer. I was instantly even more proud to be driving a Coachmen. There's a small RV park on their site where we could stay for free. They loaned us a van to drive around and explore while they worked on Sally. The techs at Coachmen gave me their cell numbers and said to call anytime—which I did. Our lock assembly on our entry door broke in Wyoming and we couldn't get out without climbing over the driver's seats. They overnighted me a new lock assembly to our camp outside of Little Bighorn. My bedroom slide stopped working in Challis, Idaho. I called Coachmen and they talked me through a fix over the phone, spending more than an hour with me. They were attentive, helpful and available whenever I needed them. I'll rep Coachmen to anyone who asks. They're marvelous.

You'll always be a part of the most amazing year of our lives, and we so appreciate it.
